

Documents certifying proficiency in a foreign language at a level not lower than B2 include:

1. A certificate, diploma, or another document confirming proficiency in a given foreign language in the following four language skills: listening, reading, speaking, and writing, at the B2, C1, or C2 level, issued by the designated institution — for English language qualifications, including:
 - University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations:
 - B2 First (FCE)
 - C1 Advanced (CAE)
 - C2 Proficiency (CPE)
 - B2 Business Vantage (BEC Vantage)
 - C1 Business Higher
 - Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (CEIBT)
 - University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations, British Council, IDP IELTS Australia:
 - International English Language Testing System (IELTS) — minimum score of 5.5
 - Trinity College London:
 - ESOL Skills for Life — Level 1 (B2) or higher
 - Integrated Skills in English (ISE) — ISE II or higher
 - ISE Digital — above 80 points (B2)
 - Educational Testing Service (ETS):
 - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL iBT) — minimum score of 72
 - Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) — minimum:
 - 785 points in Listening & Reading,
 - 150 points in Speaking,
 - 160 points in Writing
 - Pearson Assessment English:
 - Pearson English International Certificate — paper-based or computer-based version (formerly Pearson Test of English General (PTE) or London Tests of English) — Level 3 (Edexcel Certificate in ESOL International Level 1 — Pass, Merit, or Distinction) or higher
 - Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE Academic), both in-center and online versions — minimum score of 59
 - LanguageCert (PeopleCert Qualifications):
 - LanguageCert International ESOL Communicator B2 (Listening, Reading, Writing) together with Speaking component, or higher
 - LanguageCert Academic B2 or higher
 - LanguageCert Test of English B2 or higher

2. A certificate confirming completion of a preparatory course for undertaking higher education studies, referred to in Article 60(4) of the Act of 12 December 2013 on Foreigners, lasting no less than 9 months, certifying proficiency in a given foreign language in listening, reading, speaking, and writing at B2, C1, or C2 level.
 3. A diploma of completion of first-cycle, second-cycle, or long-cycle Master's degree studies in philology in the given foreign language or in applied linguistics, issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or by a foreign university, together with a diploma supplement or certificate confirming that the number of hours of instruction in the given language amounted to at least 500.
 4. A diploma of completion of first-cycle, second-cycle, or long-cycle Master's degree studies issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or by a foreign university, containing information on the language of instruction; if the diploma does not contain such information, a diploma supplement or certificate confirming the language of instruction must also be provided.
 5. An International Baccalaureate Diploma — with regard to the primary language.
 6. A European Baccalaureate Diploma — with regard to the first language (L1) or second language (L2).
 7. A certificate granting the right to practice as a sworn translator/interpreter of the given foreign language, issued by the Minister of Justice pursuant to Article 5(2) of the Act of 25 November 2004 on the Profession of Sworn Translator and Interpreter, or a certificate confirming entry on the register of sworn translators/interpreters of the given foreign language.
